Constituted in the National Guard in 1921 as 12th Balloon Group Headquarters, assigned to the III Corps, and allotted to the state of Pennsylvania. Redesignated as Headquarters, 33rd Balloon Group on 25 January 1923. Unit placed on the deferred list 2 July 1923 as a Deferred National Guard (DNG) unit, and replaced in the mobilization plan by the 53rd Balloon Group (DNG). Redesignated as Headquarters, 133rd Balloon Group in 1924. Withdrawn from the National Guard on 17 September 1927 and demobilized.
