136th ACEW Squadron: federalized in the ANG on 20 Oct 51 at Beaumont, TX but moved directly to Geiger Field for training as the 101st Fighter Interceptor Wing; assigned to 25th Air Division on 6 Feb 52; moved to Portland AB, OR on 1 Feb 52; transferred to 4704th Defense Wing in Jan 53; released from 24 months active duty and returned to control of the State of Texas on 1 Oct 53.
