MXG maintains 21 F-16C and is comprised of the Maintenance Squadron (MXS) which conducts all off-equipment aircraft maintenance (back shop), the Aircraft Maintenance Squadron (AMS) provides on-equipment maintenance (flight line), the Maintenance Operations Flight (MOF) and the Maintenance Group functional area which carries out support functions for the three squadrons and the group.
