On May 18, 1953, a weather flight; the 157th Forecasting-observing Flight was organized as a unit of SCANG, under the command of Maj. Guilbert R. Graham, who taught meteorology at the University of South Carolina. The weather flight had to be deactivated five years later, because Graham had retired and Major Charles L. Dubose who followed him was promoted by ROPA to Lt. Col. and had to leave the ANG assignment. All efforts to secure and retain a qualified weather officer failed.
