OPERATIONS

The loading and unloading of aircraft is carried out by the Ramp Section. Depending on the type and size of cargo, this may entail driving a vehicle on or off the aircraft, operating a "k-loader" or a forklift to remove palletized cargo, or downloading loose items by hand. Arriving and departing passengers are also handled by Ramp. ATOC is the controlling authority for Aerial Port operations. It coordinates and supervises the various functions of the port, including dispatching loading crews and ensuring that cargo and passengers are processed and loaded in a timely fashion.
