## OPERATIONS

During that same period, with the assignment here of the 302nd AAF Base Unit in April, Hunter Field, along with other continental Air Force installations, underwent a complete change in functional organization. Under the 302nd Base Unit personnel were originally

divided into four sections but were later re-allocated into squadrons, of which there are 13 at the present time: These include Squadrons A, D, F, N, and O, which form the counterpart of the five modified airdrome squadrons originally formed to provide permanently assigned personnel for the staging project; Squadron C, colored personnel; Squadron H, Medical Corps personnel; Squadron T, composed of administrative and headquarters personnel and the counterpart of the old 36th Base Headquarters and Air Base Squadron which replaced the 35th Air Base Group; Squadron U, Service Troops; Squadron V, Military Police; Squadron W, the WAC; Squadron Y, Combat Crew personnel; and Squadron Z, redeployed personnel.
