EMBLEM



On a disc Sable, issuing from base a demi-globe Azure, gridlined Argent, in chief ten mullets radiated Or, overall and in base an enhanced mullet of the same with three radiating lightning bolts of the like fimbriated Gules, all within a narrow border Blue. Attached above the disc, a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "VIRTUS IN EXPEDITIONES CAELI" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a Gray scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "310TH OPERATIONS SUPPORT FLT" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The ten stars represent the unit's diverse strength, while protecting and supporting the parent group, symbolized by the larger main star in base. The three lightning bolts associate the unit's mission successes with honor, strength and knowledge. 29 Jul 2008
