EMBLEM

On a disc per pale Argent and Azure, a caduceus Or, detailed and shaded of the second (Light Blue), partially encircled by an alligator couchant Proper (Gray), eyed and armed of the third, all

within a narrow border Blue. Attached above the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "314TH MEDICAL SUPPORT SQ" in Blue letters. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "READY AND DETERMINED" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The caduceus symbolizes the medical profession. The alligator exemplifies the unit's tenacity and endurance in ensuring mission success.
