Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 31 March 1924, assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve, and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated by September 1925 with headquarters at Baltimore, MD. Inactivated 2 August 1929 at Baltimore by relief of personnel. Reorganized and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, 347th Bombardment Group on 1 October 1933. Concurrently, withdrawn from the Third Corps Area. Disbanded 31 May 1942.
