367th Balloon Company (565th Balloon Group)

Bay City, MI, 1922-25
Saginaw, MI, 1925-29
Inactive 1929-41

Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 29 July 1921 as the 367th Balloon Company, assigned to the 65th Balloon Group (redesignated as the 565th Balloon Group on 20 February 1924), and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Initiated in September 1922 at Bay City, MI. Relocated on 2 June 1925 to Saginaw, MI. Inactivated by June 1929 at Saginaw by relief of personnel. Redesignated as the 367th Balloon Squadron on 1 October 1933. Withdrawn from the Sixth Corps Area on 1 January 1938 and allotted to the First Corps Area. Conducted annual summer training at Scott Field, IL, 1922-29. Status: Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
