MISSION

The 372nd Recruiting Group is the U.S. Air Force headquarters directing the recruiting activities of eight regional Health Profession flights, and eight squadrons that service a market size of 83 million people with approximately 760 active-duty and civilian personnel. The group's eight recruiting squadrons include the 343rd, 347th, 361st, 362nd, 364th, 367th, 368th and 369th. The 372nd RCG is situated in 291 recruiting offices in 21 western states including Alaska, Hawaii, and the Pacific Rim, covering more than 4,151,325 square miles in the U.S. western region to include Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Illinois, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming as well as Alaska, Guam, Hawaii and Japan.

The group's mission is to support Air Force manning requirements through the accession of quality candidates in prior and non-prior service enlistments, line officer accessions, health professions and Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps commissioning programs.
