Constituted in the Organized Reserve 15 October 1921 as the 22nd Airdrome Company, assigned to the First Army, and allotted to the Third Corps Area. Initiated 2 November 1921 at Harrisburg, PA. Redesignated on the 412th Airdrome Company 25 January 1923. Inactivated 23 July 1929 at Harrisburg by relief of personnel. Redesignated on 412th Airdrome Squadron 1 October 1933. Status: Disbanded 31 May 42.
