EMBLEM



On a Blue disc, a light blue demi globe grid lined silver gray, issuing from lower right and surmounting the lower corner of a silver gray open book in upper right, overall a white eagle head detailed silver grey, beak yellow, grasping a green ribbon turned yellow and arcing around its head and one end charged with a yellow dollar sign and the other end arching behind the globe and charged with three yellow stars. Attached above the disc a white scroll edged with a narrow yellow border. Attached below the disc a white scroll edged with a narrow yellow border and inscribed MAKING A DIFFERENCE in blue letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. Green and gold are the squadron colors and with gray represent money. The ledger and the dollar sign further symbolize the comptroller mission. The eagle indicates the 436th Military Airlift Wing – the “Eagle Wing.” The globe represents the unit’s support of the worldwide military commitment of the Air Force.
