Kingman, operational in 1955, was placed in standby status in 1957 and deactivated in 1958. During Kingman's brief lifespan, the 659th AC&W Squadron operated AN/MPS-7 and AN/MPS-14 sets.

659th AC&W Squadron: activated 20 Jun 53 at Norton AFB, CA, as the 27th Air Division; moved to Kingman, AZ, 22 Jun 55; operation discontinued in Feb 58; inactivated on 15 Aug 58.
