Effective 1 Jul 1966, the 7 Maintenance Squadron, Mobile was activated, allotted to the Air Force Reserve and assigned to CONAC. It became tenant on Hill AFB and the gaining command, upon mobilization, was Air Force Logistics Command.

7th Maintenance Squadron, Mobile was ordered to active duty at Hill AFB, 25 Sep 1972

On July 9, 2011 the 707th Maintenance Squadron was activated to support the 343rd Bomb Squadron at Barksdale AFB La.

On June 4, 2012 the 707th Maintenance Squadron reached a milestone with the certification of their first nuclear and conventional load crew on the B-52H.
