EMBLEM

Celeste, a bald eagle volant Proper grasping a wrench in beak Or between three mullets arranged chevronwise Argent; issuant from base a demi-globe Azure, land masses of the third- all within a diminished bordure Blue. Attached above the disc a Light Blue scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed 714TH AIRCRAFT GENERATION in Blue letters. Attached below the disc a Light Blue scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed SOARING ABOVE THE REST in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The bald eagle symbolizes the unit's strength, dedication and devotion to duty. The three stars allude to the various functions of maintenance. The globe refers to the unit's global maintenance capabilities (Approved, 10 Dec 1998)
