EMBLEM

Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle represents national defense and military preparedness. The axle and wheel on a symbolic roadway refer to the vehicle Operations Branch and support to the 832d Air Division. The winged wheel and crate symbolize the functions of the Traffic Management Office. The pliers reflect the Squadron's vehicle maintenance functions. (Approved, 18 Sep 1990)
