The station located at Ramore, Ontario was first manned by the USAF's 912th Aircraft Control & Warning Squadron. Construction of the station itself, known as Ramore Air Station to the Americans, began in 1950.

The RCAF took over the station on 1 January 1962 and renamed the site, 35 Aircraft Control & Warning Squadron, RCAF Station Ramore.
