919th AWN Squadron: activated 16 Apr 52 at Geiger Field, WA, as the WADF; transferred to 25th Air Division on 16 Feb 53; Moved to Saskatoon Mt, A.S., Canada by 1 Jun 53; transferred to Spokane ADS 15 Mar 60; discontinued on 1 Apr 63.

FPS-6B 1953 1988 USAF site, transferred to RCAF in April 1963.

57 Aircraft Control and Warning Squadron - Beaverlodge (AB) Located on top of Saskatoon Mountain (C-21) was the 919th Aircraft Control & Warning Squadron, USAF which had taken up residence in February 1953. The squadron reported to the 25th NORAD Region.

On 1 April 1963, the RCAF took control of the site and formed 57 Aircraft Control & Warning Squadron, RCAF Station Saskatoon Mountain. In November 1963, the name was changed to 57 Radar Squadron, RCAF Station Beaver-lodge. 57 Radar Squadron became operational on SAGE on 1 May 1964.
