EMBLEM



Gules, in front of an unfurled parchment document bendwise Or shaded Sable, an open portable computer bendwise sinister Proper displaying on the screen a Pegasus in full speed Argent detailed of the third and in base an ink well Black garnished White issuant therefrom in bend a quill pen counterchanged of the like, all within a narrow bordure of the third. Attached above the disc a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed with "927TH LOGISTICS SUPPORT SQ" in Black letters. Attached below the disc a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black

border and inscribed with "LOGISTICS MOVING FORWARD" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The lap top computer is a symbol of modernization and the unit's adaptation to technical advances. The parchment document alludes to the age-old mission of logistic support. Pegasus represents the close association with the parent unit and the mission of aerial refueling. The quill and ink well reflect the wisdom, humility and determination of the squadron's personnel in the performance of their mission. (Approved, 15 Feb 2001)
