EMBLEM



On a disc per fess Azure and Or, an American bald eagle, wings displayed, clutching in its dexter talons a tomahawk and its sinister talons a juniper bough, all Proper; all within a narrow Black border. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "READY IN WAR AND PEACE" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "931ST SECURITY FORCES SQUADRON" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE.** Ultramarine Blue and Air Force Yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The blue and yellow division of the disc refers to night and day operations and the continual efforts of security force defenders. The bald eagle embodies unit vigilance and response to threats. The tomahawk and juniper bough symbolize the ability of the Squadron to execute through times of war and peace. (Approved, 22 Feb 2022)
