EMBLEM

934 Services Squadron emblem: On an ultramarine azure disc a field of sable occupies all position below the fess point. A gules an or circle is surmounted over the fields of azure and sable at the fess point The gules semi-circle is positioned on the azure field and the or is placed on the sable. An argent estoile is also centered at the fess point and is over all. The disc is bordered with ultramarine azure. An or scroll is attached above and below the disc. The scrolls are lettered with ultramarine azure. The chief scroll bears the units designation and the base scrolls denotes the squadron's motto" Service Before Self' **SIGNIFICANCE** Ultramarine blue and air force yellow are used in the design. Blue represents the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow signifies the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The red upper half of the circle on the blue background denotes the rising sun, while the yellow bottom half of the circle on the field of black signifies the moon in the evening sky. This represents the unit's diverse role and commitment to the military personnel around the clock. The silver star symbolizes the North Star and the goal of high standards of excellence. All elements reflect the unit's motto "Service Before Self." (Approved, 28 Sep 1998)

OPERATIONS

The Force Support Squadron supports Airmen and retirees through ID card services, human resources, education and training, food operations, community services, lodging, honor guard, and recreational facilities.

In CY 2020 the Force Support mission of providing excellent customer service was tested as the fight against COVID impacted its operational capabilities. An example of successfully meeting this challenge was the Food Services team which manages the FSS Dining Facility. As in-person services began to resume in Quarter 4 of 2020, the food service staff who were 50% operational, needed to transition from serving boxed meals to hot meals. They focused on process improvement to ensure the success of this migration, changing both the way they prepared and distributed meals, while creating new protocols for screening customers for COVID and ensuring social distancing in service lines.
