**MOTTO****OPERATIONS**

The 934th Support Group will provide highly qualified units and expert personnel to support peacetime and wartime tasking at any time to any location as directed by the 934 Airlift Wing or higher headquarters.

In addition to peacetime training missions, Support Group units also have responsibilities to operate and maintain base facilities and services.

In time of war, Support Group units will deploy to world-wide locations with short notice and provide services to support airfield operations including damaged runway repairs, structural and systems repair, utilities operations, combat communications, aircraft and base security, provide billeting, dining and personal services for deployed personnel and conduct mortuary service operations.

The Support Group is a functional unit of the 934th Airlift Wing, an Air Force Reserve unit which flies the C-130 Hercules cargo aircraft. The 934th Support Group consists of a Civil Engineering Squadron, Communications Flight, Mission Support Flight, Security Police Flight and Services Flight.

The 934th Support Group includes management, technical and administrative personnel in a number of career fields. The Support Group is staffed with over 330 personnel with expertise in the fields of engineering, crash rescue, fire protection, communications, computer maintenance and operations, personnel administration, information management, law enforcement, facility security, dining and lodging facilities operations, recreational services and mortuary affairs.
