Azure, issuant from base a demi-grid in perspective Or surmounted by between two stylized lightning bolts chevronwise reversed of the second detailed Brün (Bronze), a centurion helm of the last, inside Sable, garnished and plumed of the second, plume detailed of the first and of the fourth; all within a diminished bordure Or. Attached below the shield, a White scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "960TH CYBERSPACE WING" in Blue letters. Significance. Ultramarine Blue and Air Force Yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The centurion helmet represents the cyber warrior who protects and defends America's cyberspace domain. The lightning bolts symbolize the transmission and reception of signals that link the Wing to their heritage with communications. The grid signifies many different networks that are the fields of battle within the cyberspace domain. (Approved, 25 Oct 2021)
