On 15 April 1964 the first air postal flight was activated at Dobbins Air Force Base.

Major John B. Medling was reassigned from the group to serve as commander of the first air postal flight. Three airmen were assigned as cadre for the flight. The new flight shared facilities with the group for the May and June training weekends until a building and equipment could be secured.

Technical Sergeant Horace C. Coley secured all the various furniture, equipment, and supplies needed for the flight just as he had for the group. A Quonset hut and group headquarters was secured and prepared for occupancy. It was decided to wait until the annual encampment to make the actual move.
