Constituted in the Regular Army on 8 May 1929 as Headquarters, 1st Bombardment Brigade and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Kelly Field, TX, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Designated mobilization training station was the Air Corps Training Center. Activated on 25 Jun 1932 at Langley Field, VA. Inactivated on

30 Sep 1933 at Langley Field, VA, by transfer of personnel and assets to the partially activated Headquarters, General Headquarters Air Force.
