Blue represents the sky which is the area of Air Force operations. Yellow signifies the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. Red, white, and blue, the national colors, symbolize the loyalty to the country of United States Air Force members. The book denotes the advisory nature and the source of information for the Air Force Technical Advisor. The lightning bolts, symbols of communication, refer to the flow of support from the Air Force Technical Advisor to the Air Reserve Forces.
