OPERATIONS

The squadron was activated on 20 May 1943 at Kellogg Field in Michigan along with eleven other Station Complement Squadrons. The squadron had to deal with both material and manpower shortages in the weeks prior to the move to England. On 24 July 1943, the unit received orders to proceed to New York for embarkation with a departure date of 2 August. At

that time its strength was six Officers and one hundred-eight Enlisted Men. The Squadron arrived at Station F-356 on 12 August 1943.
