Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The pyramid symbolizes the power and strength of the NATO Alliance. The indentations at the base of the pyramid reflect the information and data that the unit processes. The lightning bolts indicate the swift and reliable communication capabilities of the squadron. The flight symbol

represents the squadron and its support of the 38th Tactical Missile Wing and the NATO Alliance.
