Personnel from the 2952d Combat Logistics Support Squadron (CLSS) 401st CLSS Reserve, 2849th Civil Engineering Squadron, USAF Hospital Hill, and Hill AFB deployed to Davis-Monthan AFB, Arizona for participation in exercise, "Proud Sabre 83". 25 Oct 1983

The 2952d CLSS returned a F-4E, tail number 74-0649 to the 4th TFW, Seymour Johnson AFB, NC. The aircraft had been considered a total loss after a fire had destroyed 65 percent of the aircraft following a ground accident. 25 Mar 1983
