### EMBLEM

A Black Nighthawk, shown in flight, displays the swift and silent nature of the F-117A as it approaches its intended target. White highlights around the hawk suggest the aircraft's spectral nature. The ultramarine blue background represents the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. A waxing moon and stars denotes the Air Forces ability to operate in day and night skies. The hands symbolize the care that equipment maintenance technicians take in their work with the aircraft. Five stars refer to the individual branches that contribute to the squadron's equipment maintenance capability. The hawk's red eye denotes its ability to find and track its prey.
