The 43 Air Mobility Squadron and the 43 Air Base Squadron unfurled their new unit guidons combining Airmen and functions from multiple units into new squadrons. The air mobility squadron combined Airmen from the inactivated 3rd Aerial Port Squadron and the 43rd Aircraft Maintenance Squadron.

The reorganization of the group's squadrons was driven by U.S. Air Force-wide FY15 manning reductions and will increase the group's mission focus, efficiency and synergy. The group is scheduled to be redesignated as the 43 Air Mobility Operations Group on October 1. This new construct will provide unity of command and effort for the group's diverse operations and support functions, increasing efficiencies despite a 27 percent reduction in personnel.
