OPERATIONS

The 45 Air Base Group (Reinforced) was activated on August 25, 1940. Units designated for the group at that time were: Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, the Air Base Squadron, and the First and Second Materiel Squadrons.

At the same time, the following officers were relieved from assignment with other units at Hamilton Field and assigned to the new group: Col Michael F. Davis, Group Commander Maj Harry L. Owens, Commanding Headquarters Squadron Maj Harry A. Halverson, Commanding First Materiel Squadron Maj Walter C. White, Commanding 45 Air Base Squadron Capt Reuben C. Hood, Second Materiel Squadron. Maj Charles H. Kruse, 46 Air Base Squadron Capt Alex F. Peterson, Jr., Headquarters Squadron Capt Marvin Sledge, 59 Materiel Squadron 1st Lt Charles A. States, 60 Materiel Squadron

On September 1, 1940, one hundred enlisted men were transferred from the Fifth Air Base Group at Hamilton to the new unit. Three-hundred-twelve additional enlisted men reported a week later from the Ninth Air Base Group at Moffett Field. With this force the organization was quickly whipped into shape, and the 45 began its duties of providing administration and maintenance to the post and its two tactical units, the 20th and 35th Pursuit Groups.

The short history of the 45 has been featured by hectic personnel changes in both officers and enlisted men, a condition shared with all other Air Corps units during this time of great expansion and activity.
