EMBLEM

On a white disc within a narrow black border, a black mortarboard bend sinister wise, surmounted by a red missile, winged silver-gray, pointing upward to dexter and highlighted white. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The emblem is symbolic of the squadron and its mission. The mortarboard

represents the training mission while the red missile indicates the training type of weapon with which the squadron is concerned. The eagle wings are symbolic of the speed and striking power of the missile. The black and white colors represent the night and day capability of the missile. Approved: 13 January 1959.
