

6 AIR DEPOT GROUP

MISSION

The 6 Air Depot Group's mission was the supply and repair of aircraft, particularly in support of the Lend-Lease aircraft transfers. The group was composed of a headquarters squadron, repair squadron, and supply squadron, and had seven or eight miscellaneous attached units in areas such as ordnance, quartermaster, and signal. Together with the attached units, the 6 ADG numbered 43 officers and 850 enlisted men.
