OPERATIONS

At a typical Training Command station, such as Lynn Field, Bainbridge, Ga., where the 6th Sub depot was located, there were from 225 to 260 airplanes, most of them basic trainers, BT-13As

and BT-15s. The sub depot personnel needed to service these airplanes consisted on 31 December 1943 of 8 officers and 339 civilians, of whom approximately 225 were assigned to maintenance. During December 1943, 175 airplanes were inspected, repaired, and returned to service by the 6th Sub depot.
