Constituted in the National Guard in 1921 as Headquarters, VII Corps Air Service, assigned to the VII Corps and allotted to the state of Missouri. Placed on the deferred list 2 July 1923, and unit requirement transferred to the Organized Reserve as a Deferred National Guard unit. Omaha, NE, designated as headquarters upon activation as an Organized Reserve unit, but the unit was never organized. Withdrawn from the Missouri National Guard and from the Seventh Corps Area 22 June 1927.
