OPERATIONS

Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 15 October 1921 as 7th Wing Headquarters (Attack), assigned to the Fifth Army and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Headquarters initiated in June 1922 at Cincinnati, OH. Redesignated as Headquarters, 7th Attack Wing on 8 May 1929. Inactivated by March 1930 at Cincinnati by relief of personnel.

Relieved from assignment to Fifth Army on 1 October 1933. Port Columbus Airfield, OH, designated on 21 December 1933 as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location.

Subordinate units: 1st Pursuit Group 1923-24, 308th Pursuit Group 1923-33, 315th Observation Group 1923-33, 305th Attack Group 1923-33.
