9th Civil Engineer Squadron's mission is to provide the best combat ready forces worldwide, while sustaining, building, and protecting the infrastructure, facilities, and environment for the Beale community.

The 9th Civil Engineer Squadron enables the 9th Reconnaissance Wing mission by providing superior facility, airfield, and utility system construction, operations, and maintenance; fire emergency services, explosive ordnance disposal, and emergency management; unaccompanied along with privatized family housing facilities and programs; asset optimization; and environmental security.

Our squadron consists of more than 400 active duty, civilians and contractors assigned to the base. 9th Civil Engineer Squadron maintains 23,000 acres of land, 1,740 facilities and 565 unaccompanied personnel quarters valued at \$1.1B. Beale AFB has a privatized housing partnership with Balfour Beatty Communities to provide family housing for Beale AFB families.
