## OPERATIONS

In April of 1947, 1,600 men from the 59th Air Depot stationed at Kelly Field, San Antonio, were transferred to HAAF to oversee the aircraft storage and to continue ferrying planes off the base.

In early November of 1947, AAF declared HAAF's mission "completed." In December 1947, the 59th Air Depot unit was transferred to Rome, New York, leaving just 12 officers and 170 enlisted men on the HAAF to dispose of the remaining equipment and supplies.
