It was during August 1918 that the 60th Company was organized with Lieut. Burgess as Company Commander assisted in the different departments by Lieuts. Bonney, Ramsey and Cooney. On

November 9th this Company left Florence Field for Camp Coffman, a camp built under actual field conditions. For seventeen days the Company built balloon beds, arranged camp, maneuvered balloon and practiced other work essential to efficiency on the Front. On December the Company was moved to Fort Crook where it is now stationed.
