60 MDSS supports the 60th Medical Group and the Departments of Defense and Veteran Affairs' Joint Ventures. It provides patient administration, readiness, War Reserve Materiel, logistics, human/resource management and communications support.

60 MDSS also manages the Med Group's \$310.5 million total annual expenses and more than 2,000 manpower programs with 237 authorized personnel for more than 2,400 staff. It annually supports more than 466,400 outpatient visits and directs a managed care program for more than 500,000 DoD/VA eligible beneficiaries. It also oversees the Clinical Investigation Facility, staff training and graduate medical education programs.
