The 6931st Electronic Security Squadron, Iraklion AS, Crete, started out as a mobile squadron at Brooks AFB, Texas, in 1951. After a number of moves and name changes, the 6931st found a home on the beautiful Mediterranean island of Crete.

The more than 400 officers and airmen of the squadron are responsible for an integral part of the U.S. worldwide communications network. The unit provides rapid radio relay, secure communications and command, control and communications countermeasures in support of the U.S. and allied forces.

The unit also advises U.S. and allied commanders concerning procedures and techniques which could be used to counter adversary command and control communications. It also researches electronic phenomena and transmission security.
