OPERATIONS

Earlier in 1956, Air Force Special Comm Center activated the 6932nd Communication Security Flight at Fuchu Ah" Station to monitor U.S. Air Force communications in the Far East. In turn, the 6932nd CSF opened Detachment 1, 6932nd CSF at Hickam AFB, Hawaii. The 6988th Security Flight supplanted Det 1, 6920th Security Whig and the 6932nd Comm Security Flight at Fuchu. Operating Location-1 (OL-1), 6988th Security Flight at Yokota Air Base, provided airborne intercept operators for SIGINT recon missions.

Becoming the 6988th Radio Squadron Mobile in 1958, the Fuchu-based unit continued controlling the Yokota-based airborne detachment and COMSEC work hi the Tokyo area during

1959-1963. Finally, the squadron-detachment roles reversed hi '63 when the 6988th Security Squadron activated at Yokota and the COMSEC unit at Fuchu became Detachment 1, 6988th SS. Detachment 1 COMSEC operations ended at Fuchu Air Station hi 1969.
