Significance: The Lightning Bolt represents communications, the primary mission of the 6942 ESS. The Shield and Chess Rook represent our relationship with ESC. Fortification Ramparts represent the dedication of 6942 ESS personnel to the defense of our country. Blue represents the primary theater of operation of the Air Force. Black represents the solidity of defense capabilities of US and Allies through vital communication provided by the 6942 ESS. Yellow (Lightning Bolt) represents the continued rising of the sun over a free world through defense capabilities provided by the 6942 ESS.
