EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, below a stylized pair of wings in vol Gris, a molar with roots to base Argent, in chief a hurt, fimbriated of the third, charged with a mullet Or, surmounted by a torteau, all within

a narrow border Yellow. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "75TH DENTAL SQUADRON" in Yellow letters. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "NULLIS DENTIBUS NON EDITIS" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The star represents excellence. The tooth is symbolic of the unit's core function of dentistry. The wings represent both the unit's flight toward excellence as well as being members of the Air Force. The motto, "NULLIS DENTIBUS NON EDITIS," translates to "With No Teeth, You Don't Eat" in English.
