Constituted in the Organized Reserve 24 June 1921, assigned to the 90th Division, and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Headquarters initiated on 9 January 1922 at El Paso, TX. Relocated on 4 April 1925 to Dallas, TX. Redesignated as Headquarters, 90th Division Aviation on 10 March 1928. Typically conducted Inactive Training Period meetings on Sundays at Biggs Field 1922-25. Personnel used the aircraft of the 12th Observation Squadron at Biggs Field for flying training. Typically conducted Inactive Training Period meetings at Hensley Field 1925-29. Demobilized on 15 February 1929.
