Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1936 as Base Headquarters and 4th Air Base Squadron and assigned the General Headquarters Air Force. Reorganization effected by transfer of personnel and equipment from the 64th Service Squadron. Redesignated on 6 December 1939 as Base Headquarters and 4th Air Base Squadron (2 Group). Redesignated on 1 February 1940 as Base Headquarters and 4th Air Base Squadron (Double). Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1940 as HHS, 4th Air Base Group (Reinforced).
