Base Headquarters and 2nd Air Base Squadron HQ-Mitchel Field, NY, 1935-40  
Constituted and organized 1 March 1935 as the Station Complement, Mitchel Field. Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1936 as Base Headquarters and 2nd Air Base Squadron and assigned the General Headquarters Air Force. Reorganization effected by transfer of personnel and equipment from the 61st Service Squadron. Redesignated on 6 December 1939 as Base Headquarters and 2nd Air Base Squadron (1 Group). Redesignated on 1 February 1940 as Base Headquarters and 2nd Air Base Squadron (Single). Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1940 as HHS, 2nd Air Base Group (Reinforced).
