Extended federal recognition in September 1946, the sole Delaware flying unit flew fighter aircraft until 1961 and provided air defense for the mid-Atlantic area during its Korean War activation. Equipped with C-97s, the 142<sup>nd</sup> Tactical Airlift Squadron was on federal active duty during the Berlin Crisis. It converted to C-130As in 1971 and to its current C-130Hs in 1985.

At the end of FY92, 969 officers and enlisted personnel manned 15 DE ANG units, including the 142 AS at the New Castle County Airport in Wilmington.
